- 8-10 indoor league games

Boys' Spring Season: (April through June)

- 2x, 1.5 hour weekly training
- Spring club camp (March)
- 8 Spring (April-June) league games
- 1 local tournament
- 1 regional tournament

Roadrunners SC reserves the right to make alterations to the program details in accordance with the offerings of the Leagues in which the teams participate and tournament availability. Fees exclude cost of uniform, equipment and training gear. Players are responsible for purchase of a standard Roadrunners' uniform kit at its designated retail uniform supplier.

<u>Refund Policy:</u> Fees are due in full based on the program of services selected at the time a player registers. As a convenience to families, the club offers different payment options and methods. A prorated refund of fees paid is only available if the player is required to not participate for six weeks or more within the same season, or if the family transfers more than 25 miles from current residence. No refunds are provided after December 31.

If a player should decide to withdraw from a season, seasonal fees remain due in full as the club commits staff and resources based on the services selected by families. Club credits for use in the next soccer season may be provided on a pro-rata basis in these situations.

<u>Fees are Estimates for Actual Services</u>: As estimates of actual team expenses, these fees are subject to change based on the level of services provided. For example, Select level teams may arrange for specialty training, or

regional tournaments that are above and beyond the Club's standard. In these cases, the Team Manager will advise participating families of the additional fees due and collect fees and make payments directly.
