President's Letter

from Tony Camilleri

One of the benefits of being a Fremont Federal Credit Union member is that we are able to take advantage of the credit union tax exempt status. If you are like many members, you may not even realize that credit unions are tax exempt and may not understand exactly what that means for you.

Fremont Federal Credit Union is member owned. We do not have stockholders that we pay dividends to or paid directors that collect a salary. Our Board of Directors is comprised of community members who volunteer their time to serve on our board.

We are a not-for-profit organization, which means we are able to return our earnings to our members in the form of lower rates on loans, higher returns on savings accounts and lower/fewer fees across the board. In fact, for every \$1 of our tax exemption, credit unions return \$10 to consumers in the form of better rates and lower fees!

In Washington, Congress is working on a tax reform proposal that jeopardizes our tax exempt status. They are taking a "wipe the slate clean" approach and are wiping out tax exemptions on over 400 entities, including credit unions. Because of this approach, credit unions must now re-affirm our exempt status or the exemption will be eliminated completely. If we lose our tax exemption, credit union members everywhere can expect to pay higher fees and higher interest rates on loans. Simply stated, we will no longer be able to offer you the same financial benefits that you currently enjoy.

Now is the time for us to stand up and be heard! So far, more than 3,000 messages from Ohioans opposing the removal of our tax exempt status have been sent to Congress, but millions are needed for us to be successful. We are asking our employees, Board members and all of our membership to take action now! *Please consider taking 3-5 minutes to send a pre-written message to members of Congress. Visit www.
