THE ITALIAN AMERICAN SOCIAL CLUB OF PALM COAST, FLORIDA 1974

In commemoration of the fortieth anniversary, here is a synopsis of the beginning of the club. On November 20, 1974 thirty one interested people met at the Palm Coast Yacht Club to form an organization known as the title above. By June of the following year the members held their first election for officers of the club. The following were elected, Carmine Izzillo, as president, Jean Molinari as Vice-President, Sam Merenda as Treasurer, Madeline Lee as Secretary and Jack Lee, as Sergeant of Arms. Directors were Tom Albano, Mary Augustine, and Ray Evans.

From that meeting they planned and held their first annual picnic at Bulow Park in August of that year. Soon after, the board created a social calendar with the first event being a celebration of the formation of the club with the first Anniversary dinner held in November of 1975 at the Palm Coast Yacht Club. Sixty-three members attended. The following May the club had its first Festa which they named Bicentennial Festa in celebration of 200th year anniversary of the United States. They held the event on the Yacht Club grounds. It was a success, serving four-hundred dinners. It was also at about this time the state of Florida recognized their application as a corporation and issued the clubs first charter.

The following year the club made it first charitable contribution to the Harry Anna Children's Hospital, later that year to the Girls Scouts, with that in mind the members discussed becoming a non-profit organization, which they did. The following year they began discussing developing a club house. After three years of planning the members had a ground breaking ceremony on March 23, 1980, by June 14, 1981 they held an open house; three days later the Club honored the volunteers with a dinner. The first outside affair for the club was the Palm Coast Republican Club Installation Dinner held on June 20th. And here we are forty-years later and still going strong with six-hundred and sixty-two members as of October general meeting.

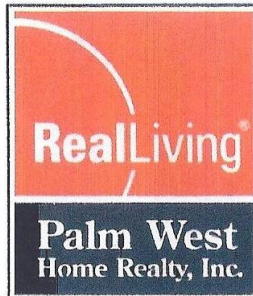
