## Points System:

$1^{\text {st }}$ place 6 points, $2^{\text {nd }}$ place 5 points, $3^{\text {rd }}$ place 4 points, $4^{\text {th }}$ place 3 points, $5^{\text {th }}$ place 2 points, $6^{\text {th }}$ place 1 point.
Ribbons are awarded through $6^{\text {th }}$ place. WRC members receive an additional point for entering each class for their member year end division awards. This excludes the exhibition classes. These points also count for the WRC Year-end Overall Member Award total.

GENERAL RULES - WRC is practicing social distancing pre entry is required to limit points of contact for our safety and yours.

1. Points are collected on a horse/rider combination and assigned a number for the season.
2. Check made payable to WRC. Any returned check will be charged an additional according to the Resubmit policy.
3. Entry Fees: By division $\$ 60$ : Miniature Horse or VSE or by class $\$ 12.00$ each
4. Grounds Fee* is $\$ 5.00$. Grounds fee waived for WRC Members.
5. Office Fee is $\$ 10$.
6. Health requirement: All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please present at the show office. Negative Coggins required. Please show at Office upon arrival.
7. Pre entry required Wednesday prior to Show. Additional class entries day of show must be made at least two (2) classes prior to the one you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form.
8. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
9. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.
10. Judge's decision shall be final! If you wish to speak with the judge contact the show office.
11. Safe riding attire is expected - i.e. boots/shoes with heels
12. Camping - A limited number of electrical hook ups are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. $\$ 25$ camping fee.
13. The WRC shall not be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
