# PERFECT PICNIC QUILT

If you're headed out for a picnic, be it in the living room or in the park, we've got the blanket covered! We've got the tips and tricks you need to make cutting and sewing a walk in the park. Recreate this cute pattern for your next picnic bash! Featuring Picnic Whimsy by Rebekah Ginda for Birch Fabrics.

FINISED SIZE: 50" x 50"

FABRIC SHOWN: Picnic Whimsy by Rebekah Ginda

### CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- •From the cream solid cut:
  - 7 strips 2" x WOF (width of fabric); crosscut all into: 144 pieces, 2" x 2"
  - 9 strips 4 1/2" x WOF; crosscut 4 of the strips into: 20 pieces, 4 1/2" x 6 1/2"
- •From the grass and teal solids cut:
  - 1 strip 2" x WOF; crosscut into 12 pieces, 2" x 2"
  - 1 strip 3 1/2" x WOF; crosscut into 4 pieces, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- •From the orange solid cut:
  - 2 strips 2" x WOF; crosscut into 24 pieces, 2" x 2"
- •From each of the printed fabrics cut:
  - 1 strip 3 1/2" x WOF; crosscut into 8 pieces, 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- •For the border, either sew together the scrap printed and solid colors, or single fabric of your choice to make:


1 strips 2" x 44.5"

2 strips 2" x 46.25"


1 strip 2" x "49.75"


## METHOD:

•Place one 2" x 2" square over one corner of a 3.5" x 3.5" block, squaring up the sides. Sew from one corner of the 2" x 2" square to opposite corner.



- •Cut off the corner 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press open.
- •Repeat steps 1 and 2 for three corners.







## PERFECT PICNIC QUILT

EACH BLOCK MEASURES: 6.5" x 6.5"

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 1/4"

#### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- •For Quilt Top:
  - -1/4 yards of the following prints from Picnic Whimsy:

Alphabet Soup

Mushroom Forest

Breezy Floral

Leaves Orange

Leaves Teal

Lurking

Picnic Main

-1/4 yards of the following Birch Organic Solids:

Orange


Grass

Teal

- -1.5 yards of cream fabric for sashing and blocks
- •To finish the quilt:
  - -1/2 yard for binding
  - -3 yards of 44" wide fabric for backing
  - -52" x 52" of batting



•Once you have 4 mini blocks, you can create a finished square. Sew 4 of the mini blocks together to create one 6.5" x 6.5" block.



•Repeat steps 1 through 4 to create 16 finished blocks.

•Create rows of 4 blocks and 5 pieces, 4.5" x 6.5".





















•Sew each row to the 4.5" x WOF pieces.



•Lastly, attach the boarder to the main body of the quilt. Then make a quilt sandwich with your quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt, bind and enjoy!
