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


#### **SIZE CHART**

Please reference this size chart when choosing the size to make for your child.



#### **PREPARATION**

Assemble the Chickadee pinafore sewing pattern pdf and cut out the required size from recommended (pre-washed/shrunk)fabrics.





#### MAKE PIPING

Cut 1.5" strips of organic denim cross grain or on bias. Join strips together for longer lengths of piping.



Pold fabric in half width wise matching long edges and place cord inside lined up with folded edge. overleck edge of piping or baste close to the cord.



#### **ASSEMBLING POCKETS**

- Using zipper foot, baste piping to pocket opening on dress front (optional).
- 2 Sew pocket facing to dress front, right sides facing (RSF) along pocket opening. cut into seam and then press facing to reverse of dress.
- Match up pocket facing and pocket back RSF, and overlock curved edge.
  Switch to regular sewing foot and baste pocket to side seam.
- Top stitch with 2 lines of contrast stitching.
- Repeat steps 1-5 for other pocket







### **TOP TIP!**



you may find it useful to use either iron on stabiliser or freezer paper to keep the shape of the pocket. Once you have finished sewing you can just rip the

paper off.

#### STRAPS

- Baste piping to straps.
- Place lining straps and main straps RSF and sew together leaving bottom edge open.

  Turn straps right sides out (you may like to trim seam allowances to reduce bulk.

  Overlock raw edge.
- Sew buttons in place.







#### **ASSEMBLING DRESS**

- Baste piping to top, bottom and sides of dress and baste straps in place on back of dress. To finish the piping; trim some of the piping from one end, line up the other end of piping. fold under the raw edge of the fabric covering by 1/4" and sew in place.
- With front and back of dress RSF, sew side seams. Repeat for lining.
- Sew the elastic to the piping at the back waist of the main dress, stretching the elastic as you go. overlap side seams by 1/4".

















- Fold under hem allowance on both main and lining dresses and hand sew using a blind stitch or stitch in the ditch top stitching.
- Sew button holes on front of dress.





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



