



LARGE THROW

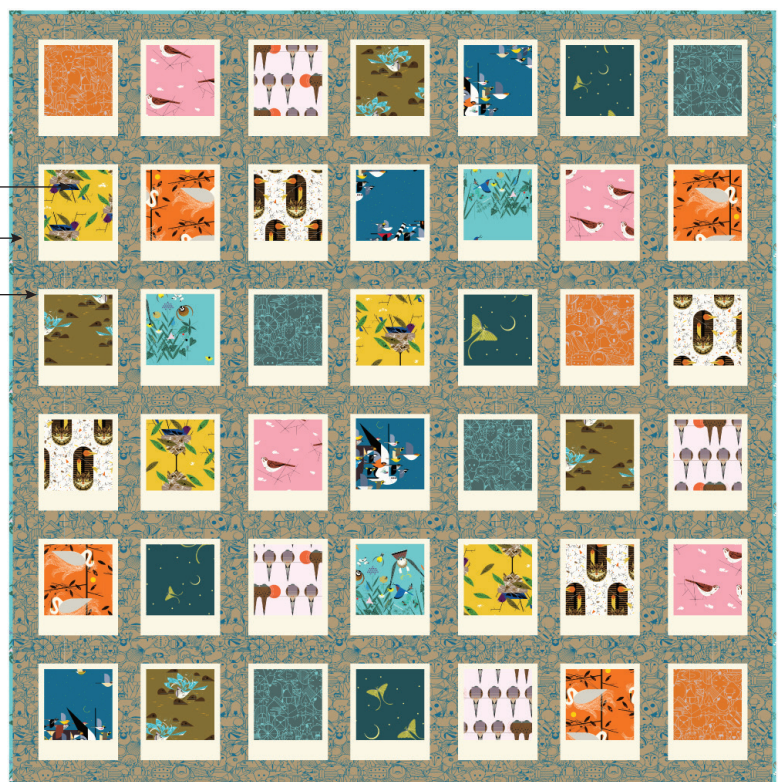
FEATURING FABRIC FROM BEST OF CHARLEY HARPER VOL.3

For this version, we use all 12 prints of Best of Charley Harper Vol. 3. Although quarter yards will work for this size, fat quarters will allow for fussy cutting on larger scale prints. We used End Papers Maple as the background fabric, and these alternative instructions will accommodate for the directional fabric.

The large throw size measures 65" square.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

	COLOR 1 - 11	FQ's	Picture Blocks
	COLOR 12	1 ¾ yd	Background
	COLOR 13	1 ½ yd	Frames
	BINDING	½ yd	
	BACKING	4 yds	



CUTTING

COLOR 1 - 11

• (4) 6.5" x 6.75" rectangles of each print.
Take care that the 6.75" measurement is on the vertical side. You will have 2 extra rectangles.

CUTTING cont.

COLOR 12

- (3) 9" x WOF strips, sub cut into (48) 2.5" x 9" rectangles.
- (12) 2.5" x WOF strips. Sew these together to make one long strip, then sub cut into 66" sections.

COLOR 13

- (2) 6.75" x WOF strips, sub cut into (84) 1" x 6.75" rectangles.
- (1) 7.5" x WOF strip, sub cut into (42) 1" x 7.5" rectangles.
- (3) 7.5" x WOF strips sub cut into (42) 2.5" x 7.5" rectangles.

ASSEMBLE BLOCKS AS SHOWN ON PAGE 2 FOR A TOTAL OF 42 BLOCKS.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Directional Fabric Friendly!

- Sew the **COLOR 12** 2.5" x 9" rectangles to the picture blocks as shown to create strips. Press toward the darker fabric.
- Sew strips together using the prepared 2.5" x 66" **COLOR 12** strips. Press toward the darker fabric.
