BIG BUDDY SCHOLARSHIP - DALLASTOWN AREA COMMUNITIES THAT CARE- A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a Dallastown Area School District high school senior who has been a Big Buddy in good standing for at least two years. This scholarship may be used for any type of post-secondary education program. Applications are available in the Counseling Office and on Naviance. Applications are due in the high school Counseling Office no later than the last Friday in March.

DELTA KAPPA GAMMA - Applicants must attend a college/university in pursuit of a **teaching** career. This scholarship requires a **transcript and letters of recommendation. PLEASE ALLOW 3-5 DAYS FOR A TRANSCRIPT.**
