Register

Registration creates a frozen version of the project that can never be edited or deleted but can be withdrawn. Your original project remains editable but will now have the registration linked to it. Things to know about registration:

- · Ensure your project is in the state you wish to freeze before registering.
- · Consider turning links into forks.
- Registrations can have embargo periods for up to four years. If you choose an embargo period, the registration will
 automatically become public when the embargo expires.
- Withdrawing a registration removes the contents of the registrations but will leave behind a log showing when the registration was created and withdrawn.

The Effect of Action, Inaction, and Counterfactual Thinking on Derived Meaning

Description: I examined whether the type of event (action vs. inaction) would moderate the effect found by Kray et al. (2010) where counterfactual reflection of a life turning point derived more meaning than direct reflection of a turning point. Ultimately, I found a main effect of type of event on derived meaning and regret, but was unable to replicate the effect of type of reflection on derived
