Assignments


- There will be no physical agenda.
 Assignments will be posted in student's Google Classroom.
- Homework is also posted on the classroom board, Remind, and Team Persistence webpage.
- Students are made aware of projects,
 papers, tests and quizzes ahead of time.
 (3 days to a week in advance)



Remind text messages

Remind is a text messaging system.

You will only need to use the codes for your child's classes.





- Homework will be assigned on most evenings (approx. 30-50 minutes worth). Students will be expected to read every evening as part of their homework.
- If your child is struggling with homework, have your child email their teacher that evening. The teacher will help them the next day.
- Individual teachers will contact parents with recurring late assignments.

C.A.R.E.S.

- School-wide Behavior System (CARES)
- Rewards will take place each month.
- > Teachers reward students with tickets to purchase items monthly in the Team Store.
- Parents are welcome to donate items for our team store.
- Other positive rewards include recess passes, bucket fillers, lunch bunch, & DAIS shout outs on morning announcements.



Language Arts

- Expect your child to read 15 to 20 minutes every night.
- Encourage your child to write stories and poems for fun! This year we will be creating Poetry Books!
- Students will expand their vocabulary and grammar skills with Word Work activities.



Math

- Students will be flexibly grouped for math class.
- Be sure to review basic math facts and operations with your child.
- Students will be problem solving (see below).
 - > Place Value
 - ➤ Multiplication/Division
 - Decimals/Fractions
 - > Measurement
 - > Geometry

Science

Students will have about 45 minutes a day for every 6 weeks each trimester.

Midterm evaluations will be sent out in the middle of each 6 week period. Example: If your child does not have Science you will not see any grades.

Social Studies

Students will have about 45 minutes a day for every 6 weeks each trimester.

- American History

- Study guides
- Study a little each night

Technology

- Each student will have their own chromebook for school activities ONLY.
- Chromebooks MUST be charged every night.
- Google Classroom is accessible from home.
