

## Other Claims Scheme Definitions

<b>Term</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>Apostolic Group</b>	The group of men with overall responsibility for the direction of the Church.
<b>Application</b>	An application by an applicant to the Other Claims Scheme.
<b>Associated Entity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Skaino Atmos Limited (previously named Skaino Services Limited);</li> <li>• TBS Building Supplies Limited;</li> <li>• House of Goodness Limited;</li> <li>• White &amp; Bishop Limited;</li> <li>• Jesus Fellowship Life Trust Limited;</li> <li>• Jesus Fellowship Housing Association Limited (until 3 March 2020);</li> <li>• Jesus Fellowship Life Trust; and</li> <li>• Jesus Fellowship Church.</li> </ul>
<b>Attorney</b>	A person who has a Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA) as registered with the Office of the Public Guardian (OPG).
<b>Commencement Date</b>	The date upon which the Jesus Fellowship Redress Scheme begins, which is now agreed as 26 <sup>th</sup> September 2022.
<b>Covering Authority</b>	The senior leadership of the Church.
<b>the Decision</b>	The Scheme Solicitors' response to the Other Claims Application Form and supporting documents, which will include confirmation as to whether the Application is accepted or rejected.
<b>Eligible Applicant</b>	A person who fulfils the eligibility criteria set out in the application guidance.
<b>Existing Claimants</b>	Eligible Applicants who have already commenced, but not resolved, a claim for compensation against the Trust.
<b>Last Application Date</b>	The final date by which an Application to the Other Claims Scheme can be made which is 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2023.
<b>Lasting Power of Attorney</b>	A legal document that enables any individual over the age of 18 years and who has mental capacity to choose another individual or individuals (called <u>Attorneys</u> ) to make decisions on their behalf

	and which is registered with the Office of the Public Guardian (OPG).
<b>Litigation Friend</b>	An individual who offers support to an Eligible Applicant who lacks capacity and who can fairly and competently conduct an Application on behalf of that Eligible Applicant and who has completed a certificate of suitability (N235 form) to be filed with the court.
<b>New Eligible Applicants</b>	Any person who has not commenced a claim for compensation prior to the Commencement Date and whose Application to the Other Claims Scheme is made after the Commencement Date and before the Last Application Date.
<b>Nominated Representative</b>	A family member, friend or individual that can assist the Eligible Applicant with their Application and who has provided a signed Nominated Representative Form.
<b>Nominated Representative Form</b>	The form that can be downloaded from <a href="http://www.jesus.org.uk">www.jesus.org.uk</a> and which must be used by a Nominated Representative.
<b>Other Claims Application Form</b>	The online form which specifies the core agreed information and which is accompanied by any relevant supporting documents, and which enables the Scheme Solicitors to process the Application
<b>Other Claims Scheme</b>	A scheme to address potential claims relating to individual employment matters and/or specific individual representations to the Trust
<b>Redress</b>	Due to the nature of these type of claims, both eligibility and appropriate types of Redress will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
<b>Representative</b>	Solicitor, Litigation Friend, Attorney or Nominated Representative.
<b>Scheme Solicitors</b>	Clyde & Co 2 New Bailey Square, Stanley Street, Salford, M3 5GS, who will deal with applications on behalf of the Trust.
<b>Solicitor</b>	A qualified legal practitioner who is regulated by the Solicitors Regulation Authority and who provides specialist legal advice on different areas of law and is responsible for representing and/or defending a client's legal interests.
<b>the Trust</b>	Jesus Fellowship Community Trust.
