North Texas Vs. Oklahoma State Live Stream: Watch NCAA Tournament Game.The North Texas Knights and Oklahoma State Tigers will kick off the NCAA Tournament on Wednesday night with their Second Four matchup at UD Arena in Dayton, Ohio.



The two teams will compete for the chance to earn the No. 16 seed in the East region. The winner will face the top-seeded Purdue Boilermakers.

The 19-15 Knights received a berth in the NCAA Tournament despite losing in the finals of the Northeast Conference tournament to Merrimack University. The Merrimack Warriors are transitioning from Division II to Division I and thus were ineligible for the NCAA Tournament.

The 14-20 Tigers earned the trip to Dayton after winning the Southwest Athletic Conference tournament.

Oklahoma State enters as a 2.5-point favorite with the total set at 147.5 on FanDuel Sportsbook.

What to Know

The Oklahoma State Tigers and the North Texas Knights are set to clash at 6:40 p.m. ET March 15 at University of Dayton Arena in the 0th round of the NCAA Tournament. Oklahoma State will be strutting in after a win while the Knights will be stumbling in from a loss.

Oklahoma State earned some more postseason success in their game this past Saturday. They came out on top in a nail-biter against the Grambling Tigers, sneaking past 61-58. Guard PJ Henry (19 points) was the top scorer for Oklahoma State.

Speaking of close games: North Texas was just a bucket short of a victory last week and fell 67-66 to the Merrimack Warriors. One thing holding North Texas back was the mediocre play of forward Ansley Almonor, who did not have his best game: he finished with only seven points on 3-for-10 shooting in his 25 minutes on the court.

Barring any buzzer beaters, Oklahoma State is expected to win a tight contest Wednesday. But bettors beware: they are only 3-12 against the spread when favored.

North Texas's defeat took them down to 19-15 while Oklahoma State's win pulled them up to 14-20. If Oklahoma State want to win, they will need to focus on stopping North Texas's forward Cameron Tweedy, who had 13 points along with nine boards, and guard Demetre Roberts, who had 15 points and six assists. We'll see whether or not they are up to the challenge.

PJ Henry is coming off three big games in the SWAC Tournament. The senior guard from Houston averaged 18.7 points per game and shot 40.9% from 3-point land during the tournament. For his efforts, he was named the SWAC Tournament MVP.

In addition, Oklahoma State is the best rebounding team in the SWAC. The Tigers average 37.7 rebounds per game, which leads the conference and ranks 37th in the country. They also lead the SWAC in rebound margin (2.1 rebounds per game).

Why North Texas can cover

North Texas has the most efficient offense in the NEC. The Knights average 106.2 points per 100 possessions, according to , which leads all conference teams. They also average 77.8 points per game, which also is the best in the NEC and ranks 42nd in Div. I.

In addition, North Texas has a playmaking guard in Demetre Roberts. The 5-foot-8 transfer from St. Thomas Aquinas leads the team in scoring (16.7 points per game) and assists (4.3). For his efforts this season he was named to the all-NEC Second team.
