Subject: Proposal of the Ministry of Railways on removal of ceiling in respect of Night Duty Allowance (NDA) - regarding

The undersigned is directed to refer to the Ministry of Railways (MoR) OM No. E(P&A)II-2017/HW-1 dated 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 and OM dated 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 regarding removal of ceiling in respect of Night Duty Allowance (NDA) for employees of the Railways.

2. The proposal has been considered in this Department and it is agreed that:

- (i) NDA may be granted to all eligible non-gazetted employees of Ministry of Railways upto Pay level - 7 (including those who are granted the benefit of MACP in Pay Level - 8). However, maximum Basic Pay for working out hourly rate of NDA shall remain ₹43600/- i.e. the prescribed ceiling fixed by DoP&T vide OM dated 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2020.
- (ii) It shall be admissible from the date of issue of the orders on the subject.
- (iii) Other terms and conditions to grant NDA shall remain unchanged as issued vide DoP&T OM dated 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2020.
