I concur with IO (b)(6) recommendation for Warning Conference in leui of Revocation. The licensee has shown an improvement on the number of instances in repeat violations. Violation 478.102(a) and 478.124(a) was the result of a lower receiver that was sold as an accessory by an employee who thought it was an accessory at the time of sale. The firearm was (b)(6) i Violation 478.121(c) was amended to 478.21a. At the time of entry, Spartan would not allow this citation to be chosen. An amended ROV has been issued to reflect this change. I recommend a warning conference be held with the RP and additional training be conducted to his employees.

Industry Operations Investigator (b)(6) Recommendation Warning Conference

Details

The field inspection was conducted on 06/07/2021 - 07/01/2021. A ROV was issued for five recordkeeping violations, including 2 NICS instances and two conduct of business violations. Revocation was merited as a result of the following violations: 27 CFR 478.124(a), Failure to execute a Form 4473 and 27 CFR 478.102(a), Failure to conduct a NICS check. The one instance of both violations involved an employee selling a receiver thought to be a firearm accessory. License had reported the firearm a missing prior to commencement of the inspection. Neither were cited during the previous inspection conducted on 04/30/2019; 27 CFR 478.125(e), failure to properly maintain the A&D record, including interam in instances. This included instance of a firearm discovered and reported missing after the inventory reconciliation. This repeat violation was cited during the 2019 inspection. There were a greater number of instances in instances in instances found were due to the licensee use of a new electronic A&D system, Pawnmaster. The licensee began using the new system in June 2019. The license was advised to contact Pawnmaster for updates to the system; and 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1), failure to obtain a properly completed form in instance. The license failed to halt the sale when the buyer answered "yes" in item 21.a. indicating that the buyer was a straw purchaser. This violation is now cited in SPARTAN in lieu of 27 CFR 478.21(a), forms prescribed. The instance is fewer than instances cited for 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1) and 478.21(a) during the 2019 inspection. The four remaining violations were appropriately addressed by issuance of the ROV and Warning Letter when taking into account the licensee's inspection history. The 2019 inspection resulted in a total of ten violations as opposed to the current number of seven violations. Also, the current inspection revealed fewer instances of the repeat violations.





Violation of 27 CFR 478.125(e): Failure to maintain an accurate/complete/timely acquisition and disposition record of firearms in ____instances.

In response to this violation, Mr. Todd explained that he maintains both electronic and manual A&D record books. Mr. Todd plans to continue using the electronic A&D as the "Official" record and plans to correct the electronic record on a case by case basis. However, since the system generates and/or captures incorrect disposition information for transferred and non-transferred firearms and will require the identification privately made firearms (PMF), the licensee was advised to either contact the software company for a solution, obtain new software or use the manual A&D record as the "Official" record. The licensee was also advised to conduct regular inventories in order to ensure that all firearms are accounted for and to detect discrepancies and errors in the physical and A&D record inventories.

The licensee was instructed on and provided portions of the updated Federal Register involving the following: Requirements to serialize firearms that do not have a serial number before transfer beginning 8/24/2022; Requirement to identify privately made firearms in the A&D record; sales of a firearm kits requiring an ATF Form 4473 and background check; and types of firearm activities performed by gunsmiths and a firearm manufacturers.

Violations of 27 CFR 478.124(a) Failure to execute an ATF Form 4473 and 27 CFR 478.102(a) Failure to Complete a NICS/POC background check both in involving the transfer of a receiver.

During the conference, Mr. Todd stated that the individual who sold the receiver will no longer work in the store and that the firearms parts and receivers will no longer be offered for sale at the store. Mr. Todd further explained that the electronic system provides an alert to obtain purchaser ID when a firearm is purchased. Mr. Todd was advised that training and educating all store employees helps to ensure that firearms are not transferred without accurate completion of the ATF Forms 4473 and background checks.

You should be aware that any willful violations of the Gun Control Act may result in revocation of your Federal firearms license. As a result of the recently cited violations, it is important that we have a meeting with you to discuss the violations found. The conference will be held at 2635 Century Pkwy NE, Atlanta, Georgia 30345 on 08/04/2022 at 1:34 PM. The agenda for the meeting will include a discussion of the reasons for the violations, a review of the legal requirements, and a discussion of steps to be taken by you to ensure future compliance. Although we do not believe it necessary, legal counsel may assist you at your own expense if you so choose. Please bring with you documentation verifying the corrective action you have taken and any compliance plan you have developed to ensure these violations do not recur.

Also, you are hereby notified that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 930(a), no person may bring a firearm or other dangerous weapon into an ATF office. Possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon in an ATF office may result in a fine of \$100,000 or imprisonment for not more than 1 year or both.

The records you are required to maintain and the business operations you conduct are important to law enforcement in our continuing effort to reduce violent crime and protect the public. It is essential that you comply with all Federal laws and regulations that govern your firearms business to aid in this effort to combat violent crime.

We will conduct a follow-up inspection in the future. Any violations, either repeat or otherwise, could be viewed as willful and may result in the revocation of your license.

This letter is a follow-up to the warning conference held with you on August 4, 2022 at 2:34 PM. During this conference, the violations cited during the inspection conducted on 6/21/2021 through 7/14/2021, and the necessary corrective action to prevent the violations from reoccurring were discussed. The following people were in attendance:

Representing the ATF Atlanta Field Division Field Division: Scena Webb and (b)(6)
Responsible person(s) representing the licensee: JOHNNY DEWITT TODD
Non-Responsible person(s) representing the licensed (b)(6)

You were given the opportunity to comment on the violations and what specific action you have taken to ensure that the violations will not reoccur. With respect to the cited violations, we are providing a summary of your response to each violation:

Violation of 27 CFR 478.125(e): Failure to maintain an accurate/complete/timely acquisition and disposition record of firearms instance:

In response to this violation, Mr. Todd explained that he maintains both electronic and manual A&D record books. Mr. Todd plans to continue using the electronic A&D as the "Official" record and plans to correct the electronic record on a case by case basis. However, since the system generates and/or captures incorrect disposition information for transferred and non-transferred firearms and will require the identification privately made firearms (PMF), the licensee was advised to either contact the software company for a solution, obtain new software or use the manual A&D record as the "Official" record. The licensee was also advised to conduct regular inventories in order to ensure that all firearms are accounted for and to detect discrepancies and errors in the physical and A&D record inventories.

The licensee was instructed on and provided portions of the updated Federal Register involving the following: Requirements to serialize firearms that do not have a serial number before transfer beginning 8/24/2022; Requirement to identify privately made firearms in the A&D record; sales of a firearm kits requiring an ATF Form 4473 and background check; and types of firearm activities performed by gunsmiths and a firearm manufacturers.

Violations of 27 CFR 478.124(a) Failure to execute an ATF Form 4473 and 27 CFR 478.102(a) Failure to Complete a NICS/POC background check both in involving the transfer of a receiver.

During the conference, Mr. Todd stated that the individual who sold the receiver will no longer work in the store and that the firearms parts and receivers will no longer be offered for sale at the store. Mr. Todd further explained that the electronic system provides an alert to obtain purchaser ID when a firearm is purchased. Mr. Todd was advised that training and educating all store employees helps to ensure that firearms are not transferred without accurate completion of the ATF Forms 4473 and background checks.

Violations of: 27 CFR 478.102(b) Failure to record a NICS transaction number on the ATF Form 4473; 27 CFR 478.124(c)(1) Failure to obtain a completed ATF Form 4473; 27 CFR 478.124(c)(4); Failure to record firearm information on the ATF Form 4473 and 2 CFR 478.21(a) Failure to furnish or provide information called for by the headings and instructions pertaining to the ATF Form 4473.

In response to this violation you stated that all forms will continue to be reviewed three times before the firearm leaves the premises. The licensee was advised to remain consistent to ensure that all forms are accurately and thoroughly completed.

The licensee was instructed on and provided portions of the updated Federal Register involving the following: Requirements to serialize firearms that do not have a serial number before transfer beginning 8/24/2022; requirement to identify privately made firearms in the A&D record; sales of firearm kits requiring an ATF Form 4473 and background check; and types of firearm activities performed by gunsmiths and a firearm manufacturers.

The violations for which you were cited could adversely impact law enforcement's ability to reduce violent crime and protect the public. You are reminded that future violations, repeat or otherwise, could be viewed as willful and may result in the revocation of your license. You may anticipate further inspections to ensure your compliance.
