SOCIAL DISTANCING ADVICE FOR STAFF WORKING IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY.



WASH YOUR HANDS MORE FREQUENTLY.

You should wash your hands frequently using soap and water for 20 seconds, especially after touching a surface that may have been frequently touched by others and before touching your face (eyes, nose, and mouth in particular)



KEEP 2 METRES APART WHERE POSSIBLE.

Where it is safe and possible to do so, you should try to remain 2 metres apart from your colleagues.





AVOID SHARING EQUIPMENT

Where possible, avoid sharing equipment such as tools and machinery. If this is not possible, make sure all equipment and machinery is thoroughly cleaned after each use.

INCREASE VENTILATION

When working within an enclosed area, look for opportunities to increase ventilation such as by opening windows or doors.





STAY IN YOUR TEAMS

You may be asked by a manager or supervisor to work within a small team or pair to complete tasks that cannot be done alone, such as lifting or two person delivery. Stay within your allocated teams to help minimise transmission.

IN AN EMERGENCY...

In an emergency, for example, an accident, fire or break-in, you do not have to stay 2m apart if it would be unsafe. Those involved in the provision of assistance to others should pay particular attention to sanitation measures immediately afterwards including washing hands.
