## What is sexual harassment?

Any unwelcome conduct  
of a sexual nature in the  
FAO work environment  
that interferes with work,  
is made a condition of  
employment or creates  
an intimidating, hostile  
or offensive work  
environment.

## At FAO, we say NO to any form of sexual harassment:

- ✘ No inappropriate touching or kissing colleagues
- ✘ No unsolicited sexting or obscene emails
- ✘ No harassment on social platforms
- ✘ No displays of sexual content – posters, cartoons, graffiti – at the office
- ✘ No sexual or offensive jokes
- ✘ No derogatory or demeaning comments about someone's sexual orientation or gender identity
