- Dual Participation is only available for grades 9-12 and is not guaranteed. It is a privilege. It can be denied or revoked at any time by the administration based upon academic performance, refusal for athlete to cooperate, incompatible schedules, or any other reason deemed in the best interest of the school.
- Every sport does not qualify for dual participation. Most team sports require such a great time commitment that students will only be able to participate in one sport.
- 3) Communication is the key. If you plan on making dual participation a positive experience then the student athlete and parents must communicate with the coaches on all scheduling concerns.

Process

- Meet with both coaches **<u>BEFORE TRYOUTS</u>** to discuss the option and if it will work.
- If approved, read over Dual Participation Form and get all necessary signatures.
