FHS REMEDIATION CLUBS

In an effort to further help our Juniors on the path to graduation, Mrs. Keener, FHS Assistant Principal, with teacher input, will be implementing Remediation Clubs for some of our Juniors who are not on track to graduate under the State of Ohio's new graduation test pathways.

Some juniors will be notified, along with their parents by mail, that they have been enrolled in

club time at FHS on Wednesday mornings from 8:15 - 8:45 am, in order to help them better prepare for Ohio End-of-Course exam retakes.

These 1/2 hour sessions, held once a week, have been put together so that our students can further prepare to meet the 18-point threshold the State of Ohio demands from graduates, beginning with the Class of

2018, our current juniors.

These clubs are required and the students who have been selected are expected to be in their assigned areas at 8:15 am on Wednesday mornings. Please look for notification for some of our junior students within the next two weeks. Please contact our School Counseling office for further information regarding your child's progress toward graduation.
