PSAT INFORMATION—TEST DATE OCTOBER 10TH

PSAT FOR ALL NINTH AND TENTH GRADERS, AND SOME TOP PERFORMING 11TH GRADE STUDENTS—

The PSAT test will be administered at FHS on Wednesday, October 10th. Students taking the test are expected to be at school starting at 7:30 am. The test should conclude at approximately 12 noon, at which time students will be

excused from school. Students who need to stay will be provided lunch, beginning at the conclusion of the test, and then a study hall if they cannot get a ride home at the conclusion of the test. Busses will run at the normal times that day. There is **NO MAKEUP** test for the PSAT, as dictated by the College Board. Juniors and Seniors who are not taking the test are

expected to utilize that day to visit a college, shadow a job, or research a career.

The PSAT is an outstanding preparatory test which allows students to receive feedback on areas of strength and weakness as they progress toward taking the SAT in their junior year.
