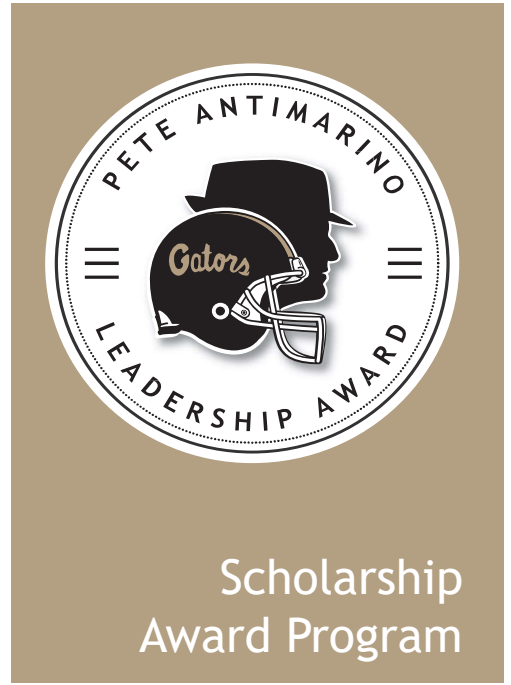

Scholarship Award Program

THE PROGRAM

The Board of Directors of the Pete Antimarino Scholarship Fund are pleased to announce that this award, in the memory of Legendary Gateway Football Coach Pete Antimarino, will provide a \$4,000 award beginning at the 2023-2024 school year to a deserving member of the Gateway High School football team. The award will be dispensed in yearly \$1,000 increments upon verification of acceptance by an institution of higher learning for the upcoming academic school year. The award is merit based.

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Coach Walter "Pete" Antimarino was the head football coach of Gateway High School from 1958 through 1990. His accomplishments were many and his coaching touched hundreds of Gateway alumni. When Coach Antimarino passed away in 2017, an initiative began to fund a scholarship in coach's honor. The award will foster and promote the values and character traits that were so important to Coach Antimarino and his loyal coaching staffs, along with thousands of former Pitcairn and Gateway High School alumni.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for the Pete Antimarino Leadership Award, the student-athlete must:

- Be a graduating senior on the Gateway Football Team.
- Be in good academic standing.
- Demonstrate leadership characteristics on and off the football field, in the classroom, and throughout the Pitcairn-Monroeville community.

STUDENT-ATHLETE MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- A completed application
- A brief 100 - 200 word typed essay answering the question: *"What being a member of the Gateway Football Team has meant to me?"*
- Two letters of recommendation: One from the academic staff, one from the athletic staff, or one from a community leader
- Official high school transcript of grades
