

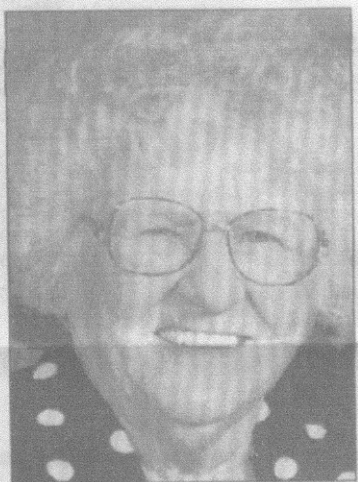
Vera Bowen
