### Obituary

Isabella Wyatt was born November 28, 1838, at Birmingham, England, and died at her home in Marshall county, Iowa, January 22, 1909, aged 70 years, 1 month and 24 days.

She was married January 25, 1860, to Alfred Luing at Barton, England, and they came to America in June of the same year. They were a few years in Wisconsin and came to Marshall county, Iowa, in 1864, living for a short time in Marshalltown and a few years at State Center. For the past 33 years their home has been on the farm where she died.

To this union were born ten children, of whom eight are living, two having died in infancy. The living children are Annie, Fannie, Earnest and George of Marshall county, Iowa, William of Story county, Henry of Milford, Iowa, and Fred and John of Minnesota. She also leaves her husband and two brothers, George and Daniel Benson of Lamoyille, Iowa, 21 grandchildren and 5 great-grand children.

The cause of death was heart failure, as result of cancer.

The funeral was held at the residence Tuesday afternoon, the service being being conducted by the minister of the M. P. church of Rhodes. All of the family and a large number

of the neighbors and friends were present at the funeral service and the interment. The latter was at the Collins Cemetery. The pall bearers were John Long, John Blumenschein, R. M. Sanders, Henry McWherter, Walter Pitcher and Wm. Wilson.
