





VOTED #1 - STATE PARK IN THE USA, 2015 - ATTRACTION IN NEW YORK STATE, 2017

Wyoming County is home to **Letchworth State Park**, a natural wonderland featuring 14,350 acres and 66 miles of gorgeous hiking, biking, horse and cross-country skiing trails.

Enjoy the **Genesee River Gorge** which splits the park in two and can be up to 600 feet deep. These incredible rock formations frame three major waterfalls, including the 110-foot drop of the Middle Falls.



Mount Morris Dam & Visitor Center

Completed in 1952, the dam includes many scenic overlooks and a 5,400 square foot visitor center filled with information and interactive exhibits. Want to go inside and explore the dam? Enjoy a free guided tour! Walking tours into the dam run April – October, Monday through Thursday at 2:00 p.m. and Friday, Saturday, and Sunday at 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. For more information, call (585) 658-4790.



The Humphrey Nature Center

The Humphrey Nature Center is a state-of-the-art facility that offers year-round environmental education opportunities, meeting spaces, and indoor and outdoor exhibits.







WE HAVE 4 SEASONS FOR YOU TO DISCOVER.

Letchworth State Park has 66 miles of trails in the park ranging from a half mile to 24 miles in distance. Trails will accommodate novice to experienced hikers and introduce you to some of the most scenic and beautiful wooded walks in New York State!

Beaver Meadow Audubon Center

is a 324-acre nature preserve in North Java, offering interpretive and outdoor recreational activities to the general public and nature lovers alike. It includes public access to over eight miles of guided trails for hiking, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, a visitor center, indoor exhibits, gift shop, nature art exhibits, animal exhibits and wildlife observation windows. Beaver Meadow is open to the public six days a week and has a staff of naturalists that provide educational support and outreach programs.

Angling for an adventure? Wyoming County is home to some of the best stream fishing in all of New York State, featuring both stock trout and wild trout. With over 34 miles of public fishing easements and 43 miles of stocked streams, Wyoming County is a fishing haven.

Our waterways provide recreational fishing opportunities — catch a variety of trout, bass, pike, perch and walleye from our lakes and streams. If you're looking to enjoy a day on Silver Lake, fish at Silver Lake State Park or rent a party boat from **Silver Lake Marine** and cast your line in style.

The Genesee Valley Greenway is a 90-mile long trail extending south from Rochester, following the Genesee River south of Portageville, NY in Wyoming County. Hike this flat trail along the Genesee River and get up close and personal with eagles, hawks and more.

Ready for a treasure hunt? Wyoming County Geocaching Trail is for you. Use your smartphone or handheld GPS and explore hidden treasures on the Wyoming County Geocaching Trail. There are 12 containers hidden in the County – each at a unique, historic and fun location. Find them all and receive collectible WyCo treasure! Enjoy biking? Letchworth State Park permits mountain biking on over 40 miles of hiking trails in the park. Enjoy easy to more challenging rides – or bike along the 17 miles of main road in the park! Outside of the park, State Route 19 is a 109-mile north-south, on-road bike path that runs from the Town of Pike to the Town Middlebury in Wyoming County.

What to do when the snow flies? Cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and more! Play in the snow by skiing and snowshoeing on the trails at **Letchworth State Park, Byrncliff Golf**

Resort & Banquets, Beaver Meadow, and many of our public lands.

Snowmobile through open woods, scenic fields and rolling hills on over 250 miles of groomed trails. Many located next to local restaurants for an easy stop and tasty break or to warm up your cold toes. Contact us for trail maps and to learn about our snowmobiling clubs.

WARSAW CIVIL WAR MONUMENT

FOUNDED IN 1841, WYOMING COUNTY HAS A UNIQUE AND FASCINATING STORY.

From historic homes and monuments, the railroad and salt industry, and Native American history, we are proud of our tradition and contribution to the American experience. Warsaw is home to multiple Underground Railroad locations and its residents were early leaders in the abolitionist movement. The Augustus Frank House (now the Artisan Villa) and the Seth Gates House (now the Warsaw Historical Society) were homes to US Representatives who fought aggressively to abolish slavery. Visit both of these places to learn the fascinating history and see artifacts and historical treasures!

If ghost hunting interests you, then you'll want to make a stop at Heaven Sent Bed & Breakfast in Portageville.

Formerly a rectory, this property is on the New York State Haunted History Trail. You are welcome to spend the night, but not to worry - these ghosts are very friendly!

Did you know Wyoming County is home to Attica Correctional Facility? Constructed in 1931 it is one of the most well-known prisons in the United States – and was the site of a nationally covered prison riot in 1971. Visit the **Attica Prison Museum** across the street from the prison to learn more and see prison artifacts! If you are interested in local town history or genealogy, visit our many local museums, libraries and historical societies. Each is a wealth of information and always eager to assist visitors with a passion for the past.
