



Wyoming County is home to **Letchworth State Park,** a natural wonderland featuring 14,350 acres and 66 miles of gorgeous hiking, biking, horse and cross-country skiing trails.

Enjoy the **Genesee River Gorge** which splits the park in two and can be up to 600 feet deep. These incredible rock formations frame three major waterfalls, including the 110-foot drop of the Middle Falls.



Completed in 1952, **Mount Morris Dam & Visitor Center** includes many scenic overlooks and a 5,400 square foot visitor center filled with information and interactive exhibits. Want to go inside and explore the dam? Enjoy a free guided tour! Walking tours into the dam run April – October, Monday through Thursday at 2:00 p.m. and Friday, Saturday, and Sunday at 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. **For more information, call (585) 658-4790**.

The landmark **Genesee Arch Bridge** featured on the cover, was completed in 2018 and spans the Genesee River over the Upper Falls. The 483 foot arch bridge sits 235 feet above the middle falls, and is a popular photo spot. The Genesee Arch Bridge can be found at the south end of the park, near the Portageville Entrance with areas to park and view the bridge structure up-close.



The **Humphrey Nature Center** (pictured above) is a state-of-the-art facility where nature-based programming focuses on geology, wildlife and botany; as well as many interactive exhibits highlighting the plants, animals, and river ecology of Letchworth State Park.



The Autism Nature Trail (The ANT) at Letchworth State Park The state park voted #1 in the country by online fans is poised to become the site of a first-of-its-kind experience in nature designed for visitors with autism and a range of disabilities.

The Autism Nature Trail (The ANT) at Letchworth State Park, a one-mile ADA-compliant hike through a stunning pine forest, offers 8 stations with activities which support and encourage sensory perception and integration, while also providing enjoyment for persons of all abilities and ages. The stations engage each individual's auditory, visual, olfactory, tactile, vestibular and proprioceptive processing, using nature and natural materials as the tools for skill-building.

Construction on The ANT began in January and will be completed before the end of the 2021 Parks season. The Trail is located adjacent to the Humphrey Nature Center near the Castile Entrance to the Park.

SOCIAL DISTANCING THE RIGHT WAY IN THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Beaver Meadow Audubon Center is a 350-acre nature preserve in North Java, offering interpretive and outdoor recreational activities to the general public and nature lovers alike. It includes public access to over eight miles of guided trails for hiking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing, a visitor center, indoor exhibits, gift shop, nature art exhibits, animal exhibits and wildlife observation windows. Beaver Meadow is open to the public six days a week and has a staff of naturalists that provide educational support and outreach programs.

The Genesee Valley Greenway is a 90mile open space corridor that passes thru five counties. It follows the route of the former Genesee Valley Canal and the Pennsylvania Railroad Rochester Branch from the Erie Canalway Trail in Rochester's Genesee Valley Park to the Village of Cuba.

The trail offers both historic and natural features. Hike the flat trail along the Genesee River and get up close and personal with wildlife including eagles, hawks and more.

Interpretive signage is provided along the trail at key locations.

Bike the Outdoors. Letchworth State Park permits mountain biking on over 40 miles of hiking trails in the park. Enjoy easy to more challenging rides or bike along the 17 miles of main road in the park! Outside of the park, State Route 19 is a 109-mile north-south, on-road bike path that runs from the Town of Pike to the Town Middlebury in Wyoming County.

recreational fishing opportunities — catch a variety of trout, bass, pike, perch and walleye from our lakes and streams. Spend a day on beautiful Silver Lake, fish at Silver Lake State Park or rent a party boat from **Silver Lake Marine**, and cast your line in style. With over 7 miles of shoreline and a maximum depth of 37 feet, Silver Lake is both recreational and a great AirBnB getaway location. It is also the home of the famous Silver Lake Sea Serpent. Visitors and local residents enjoy boating, swimming, and fishing on the lake.

Take a leisurely ride on your bike or motorcycle and enjoy the fall scenery in Wyoming County, stop for pictures, dinner, or make it a true weekend adventure.




HIT THE TRAILS!


Wyoming County ranks #1 in agriculture sales and it is an important part of our culture. We are very proud that Wyoming County is #1 in NY in the production of milk, potatoes, hay and honey. We have over 287,000 maple taps and lead the state with 700 farms producing a total of \$326 million in total agricultural sales.

As much as we enjoy growing great foods, we also enjoy eating and sharing it. Be sure to pick-up fresh fruits and vegetables at our seasonal farmers' markets, sample a variety of delicious maple products, and enjoy locally sourced foods at many of our great restaurants. Then visit places like East Hill Creamery (pictured above left), a unique artisan cheese maker in Perry or one of many great ice cream shops like Yummies in Warsaw.



Each year, nearly 20 maple producers participate in NYS Maple Weekends, covering two weekends in March. Visitors can learn how maple syrup is made directly from the producers and then stop in for some delicious pancakes drizzled with maple syrup.



WYOMING COUNTY'S HISTORIC UNDERGROUND RAILROAD CONNECTIONS



Founded in 1841, Wyoming County has a unique and fascinating story. With historic homes and monuments, the railroad and salt industry, and Native American history, we are proud of our tradition and contribution to the American experience.

Wyoming County also played a vital role in the Underground Railroad, an escape route that took fugitive slaves from points south, through Western New York and into Canada by way of Buffalo. There were several locations that served as "stations" along the way where escaped slaves could hide from search parties, replenish their food and clothing, and receive directions and encouragement from sympathizers helping the fugitive slaves gain their precious freedom. Wyoming County is proud to have played an important part in helping to free all those brave souls who passed through the area on their way to "the promised land," and recognizes all those who helped the former slaves realize the dream of living as free men and women.



Warsaw, the County seat, is home to multiple Underground Railroad locations and it's residents were early leaders in the abolitionist movement. The Augustus Frank House (now Artisan Villa) and the GATES HOUSE, WARSAW Seth Gates House (now the Warsaw Historical Society) were homes to US Representatives who fought aggressively to abolish slavery. In addition to the Underground Railroad information, the Warsaw Historical Society also offers historical and ghost walks around the Village of Warsaw, which includes a stop at the Augustus Frank House.

It is not well-known that America's first anti-slavery political party was organized in Wyoming County at the Warsaw Presbyterian Church in 1839. Wyoming County grew to have the second largest number of conductors and station masters in New York State, after Monroe County. The Fugitive Slave Act of 1850 made it illegal to harbor or help fugitive slaves. For that reason, the events of the Underground Railroad were shrouded in secrecy.

Though many of the buildings that were involved in the railroad no longer stand, there is sufficient evidence from the records of town historians, private family letters and known publications to document the part that Wyoming County played in helping escaped slaves find freedom.
