

Tour Schedule:

- Meet at Union Station's North Courtyard for a welcome by Anna Mendiola, President of the Southern California Chapter.
- Noon Walk up Alameda from Union Station to see the California Endowment and a presentation byRios Clementi Hale Studios. This site is across the street from the Cornfield, Los Angeles State Historic Park.
- 12:30 Take the DASH in front of Olvera Street and travel south to 11th and Hope. Calvin Abe, FASLA and Martha Williams will speak on South Park.

Melani Smith, Principal of Melendrez will describe the LA Live Sports and Entertainment Streetscape Master Plan and its implementation which is taking shape on the ground. She will also introduce the Grammy Walk of Fame installation, which commemorates 50 years of the Grammy Music Awards, and ties into the Grammy Museum at LA Live, opening December 6th.

A representative from Rios Clementi Hale Studios will speak on Nokia Plaza.

 - Melinda Taylor will present the Disney Hall Garden.
 - Walk to the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion and enjoy the view down to City Hall.
 - A representative from Rios Clementi Hale Studios will present the Civic Park.
 - Melani Smith of Melendrez and Ken Nakaba, FASLA, will lead a talk on the downtown core, including bringing back Broadway initiative to restore the Historic Theater District in downtown and install a streetcar again.
- 3:30 Take the METRO LOCAL LINE 14 at 1st Street and Hope Street (NE Corner) and get off at Beaudry Ave and Temple Street (NE Corner) which is the Southeast Corner of the Vista Hermosa Park where Esther Margulies, ASLA, Partner at ML+A will wrap up the day with a presentation and tour.
