**SUBJECT: CHARGES RE: AI-15-046**

An investigation has been conducted by the Administrative Investigation Division, Professional Standards Bureau, of the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. As a result of this investigation, the Administrative Review Board has determined you committed the following violation:

On August 22, 2015, while on duty in Pinellas County, Florida, you violated the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Act Laws of Florida, 89-404 as amended by Laws of Florida 08-285, Section 6, Subsection 4, by violating the provisions of law or the rules, regulations, and operating procedures of the Office of the Sheriff.

1. You violated Pinellas County Sheriff's Office General Order 3-1.3, Rule and Regulation 3.12, Good Order and Discipline.

Synopsis: While assigned to and working C-Barracks floor, you entered Pod 4 to resolve an issue with an inmate. In the pod, you flipped a dayroom table over, in effort to gain attention of the inmates, and caused minor damage to the table.

You admitted to this violation.

Disciplinary Points and Recommended Discipline Range:

You were found to have violated one Level Three Rule/Regulation resulting in fifteen (15) disciplinary points. These points, which were affected by no modified points from previous discipline, resulted in fifteen (15) progressive discipline points. At this point total, recommended discipline ranges from a Reprimand to three (3) days suspension.

Disciplinary action shall be consistent with progressive discipline, for cause in accordance with the provisions of the Pinellas County Civil Service Act.
