ITTF Development and Education & Training Job Opportunities

Three halftime positions will become available within the Development and Education & Training Programs of ITTF from 1 January, 2017. There is the possibility to start earlier in exceptional cases by mutual agreement.

A strong table tennis background in the below areas is an advantage but not essential.

Some international travel will be required, and applicants should be willing to work as required rather than regular office hours.

Fluency in both written and spoken english is required while fluency in french-spanish-arabic will be an advantage.

The ITTF Coach Accreditation Scheme began in 2004, and includes ITTF-PTT Level 1, ITTF Level 2, ITTF L3, and soon to be released ITTF High Performance, and is in 4 main languages [english-french-spanish-arabic] and multiple other languages [portuguese-estonian-farsi and mandarin-thai under translation].

The successful candidate will update the ITTF Coach Accreditation Scheme, including updating existing materials, transferring components to online learning, producing online versions of the manuals, preparation of films and new photos as required, while using world best practises of other sports as the benchmark.


