*The Trunk Road (Church Street, Highbridge, Somerset) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1960.*

On 11th October 1960, the Minister of Transport made the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, which will come into operation on 24th October 1960.

The effect of the Order is that (with certain exceptions) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. in that length of the Exeter—Leeds Trunk Road (A.8) (known as Church Street), at Highbridge, in the County of Somerset, which lies between its northern junction with Burnham Road (B.3139) and a point 100 yards south-west of its junction with Market Street (B.3139).
