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TIS REDEFINES EDUCATION

TIS provides an enriching global learning experience, and to make it more impactful, we seamlessly integrate the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) into our Primary School curriculum to build a solid foundation for students. Moving into the Secondary School, the students' learning journey culminates in the internationally recognised IGCSE exams from Cambridge Assessment International Education (CAIE) at the end of Year 11.

At the core of our education approach is Quantum Learning (QL), a research-based educational methodology that places a high emphasis on teacher effectiveness and nurtures lifelong learning. TIS proudly holds the distinction of being the first school in the world to receive the prestigious Quantum Learning Distinguished School (QLDS) award.

ENG

English is the main medium of instruction across all levels. For IGCSE, the options in English are: Literature, First Language, and Second Language.

BM

Bahasa Malaysia is taught to all students until Year 9. It is a compulsory subject for all Malaysian students, and for IGCSE, they have the opportunity to take IGCSE Malay as a Foreign Language or a First Language.



Mandarin is an integral part of the curriculum for all students until Year 9. For IGCSE, students have the option to select Mandarin: First Language, Second Language, or Foreign Language.






