"SBO and Demat of securities – Need of the hour"

Bharat is gradually being corporatized (in the form of a company or LLP) inter alia for the benefits of being regulated and recognised. As at 30th November 2023, appx. 17 lakh active companies and appx. 3 lakh active LLPs exist in our country.

Transparency has been one of the thrust areas of the present government and Significant Beneficial Owner related provisions are a step in this direction. These provisions aim to uncover ultimate beneficiaries with significant control over the corporate entities and promote corporate transparency. In the first phase, these provisions were introduced for companies in June 2018. Recently, in October 2023, these provisions have been extended to the LLPs.

Traditionally the securities have been held in physical (paper) form having difficulties in its preservation and maintenance, and susceptible to the risk of fraud, duplicate certificates etc. To address these, dematerialisation of securities is also introduced in the corporate sector in a phased manner. To begin with, the mandate was applicable to the Listed entities, then to other Public companies and now in October 2023 – to Private companies (other than small company).

It is imperative to acquaint with the SBO related provisions for the personnel connected with the relevant entities. Similarly, knowledge about regulatory requirements about dematerialization will enable the timely compliance. Corporate and Commercial Laws study circle of BCAS has organised a session to deliberate on both these topics to well equip the participants (who could be an employee of such entity or consultant or otherwise) with the nitty-gritties thereof.
