

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Article 1. Introduction

These general terms and conditions apply to all distance learning offers (online learning) from SIIL sarl. Head office is established in Montreux. All of its training is university-based.

Article 2. Program registrations

Anyone can be admitted to a Bachelor's program without the condition of a previous diploma. To register for a Master's degree, you must have a Bachelor's degree.

Article 3. Data protection

After the registration for training, the customer is informed of the processing of a personal data by the SIIL.

The SIIL collects and processes personal data in accordance with the relevant legal provisions:

Article 13 of the Federal Constitution of 18 April 1999 (Cst., RS 101) provides that everyone has the right to respect for his private and family life and has the right to be protected against the abusive use of data which concern. Article 12 of the federal law of June 19, 1992 on data protection (LPD, RS 325.1) specifically protects individuals against any unlawful attack on their personality. The Vaud law of September 11, 2007 on the protection of personal data (LPrD; BLV 172.65) provides that everyone has the right to be protected against the misuse of data concerning them.

In its capacity as controller of your personal data, the SIIL complies with these provisions.

The data retention period will be determined in accordance with the laws and regulations in force. Your personal data will be destroyed or made anonymous as soon as they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were collected.

We make every effort to ensure the security of your data and avoid any improper access, use, modification or disclosure of it. In order to guarantee the confidentiality of the data exchanged, in particular during the delivery of an online service, this site uses a regularly updated authentication certificate. This certificate also verifies that your computer is communicating with the SIIL server.

We also strive to ensure that any third party to whom your data is communicated (as described above) treats it in a secure manner to ensure its confidentiality and integrity.

Despite all the efforts made, it is not possible to fully guarantee the security of information exchanged on the Internet. Any data you transmit is at your own risk.



By registering for a course or seminar, the participant consents to SIIL's use of their personal data (contact details, statistics of courses taken, compliance with payment terms, behavior, etc.) for internal use. You also accepts that your personal data may be used by the SIIL for commercial or organizational purposes specific to the SIIL. However, they are never transmitted outside the SIIL except in an anonymous form. A participant may request at any time to no longer receive mail from the SIIL.

Article 4. Registration fees

All prices are expressed in Swiss francs. Payment must be made at the latest within 7 days from the signing of the training contract and/or at the latest 7 days before the start of the semester (of the training program).

Article 5. Cancellation of registration

Any withdrawal must be announced in writing at least 3 weeks (15 working days) before the start of the training. Any withdrawal announced in the 3 weeks preceding the course entails a deduction of 10% of the registration fee. Any withdrawal announced less than 10 days before the start of the course or during the course, entails a deduction of the entire price of the course. The postponement of a participant's registration to a later session is subject to the same conditions as a cancellation.

Article 6. Content of the training contract.

The special contract for training states:

- a. training objectives;
- b. the contents of the training;
- c. the number and profile of participants;
- d. the duration of the training;
- e. the price of the training;
- f. the dates reserved;
- g. the type of title or certificate issued;
- h. teaching methods.

Article 7. Intellectual property

The content and educational materials, in all their forms, made available to the client organization and its participants as part of training, may not be used for any purpose other than training. In particular, they may not be the subject of any other use, transformation, reproduction or exploitation without the express written consent of SIIL.

Article 8. Modification of programs and prices



The SIIL reserves the right to make changes to programs and prices at any time and without notice.

Article 9. SIIL's limitation of liability.

The SIIL is committed only on the basis of a commitment of means, to the exclusion of any commitment of result. The SIIL declines all responsibility when a continuing education course does not meet the expectations of a participant.

Article 10. Jurisdiction

The legal relations with SIIL are governed by Swiss law and the legal forum is located in Lausanne.

Article 11. Modification of these conditions

The SIIL reserves the right to change these general conditions at any time and without notice.

Article 12. Entry into force.

These general conditions come into force on September 1, 2020.
