Throughout his career duty stations have included Ft Bragg, NC and Vincenzo, Italy. Prior to being selected for the U.S. Army Parachute Team, he was assigned to Ft Benning, GA as a Drill Sergeant with D 2/58 INF. In 2010 SSG Hill attended the rigorous Golden Knights Assessment and selection and was assigned to Black Team, this is his seventh season on the Team.



SFC Adrian Hill has had 1 tour in Iraq and 2 tours in Kosovo. He has been awarded the Bronze Star, the Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal, and North Atlantic Treaty Organization Medal. Hill has also earned the Master Parachutist Badge, Expert Infantry, Combat Action, Pathfinder and Drill Sergeant Badges.

Since learning to skydive in 2005 he has logged more than 6,000 free fall parachute jumps, and 120 military static line jumps. SFC Hill holds a USPA Coach, Tandem Instructor, Accelerated Freefall Instructor, and Professional Exhibition rating.
