Presgraves enlisted into the Army more than fifteen years ago and attended Basic Training at Ft Jackson, SC. Immediately after he went to Ft Leonard Wood, MO for his Advanced Individual Training as a Military Policeman. He has also served as Squad Leader and Non Commissioned Officer in Charge, NCOIC, for several exhibitions with the 101st Parachute Demonstration Team. Kevin has served tours of Duty in Iraq and Afghanistan.



In 2011, Presgraves attended the rigorous Assessment and Selection Program for the United States Army Parachute Team. Upon completion of the program, he was knighted and assigned to the Gold Demonstration Team. In 2014 he took over as Team Leader of the Black Demonstration Team until OCT 2017 when he took the role as HHC 1SG.

Prior to making the "Golden Knights" he has earned the Purple Heart, two Bronze Star Medals, three Army Commendations, two Army Achievement Medals, Air Assault, Combat Action Badge and Driver's Badge.

Kevin began jumping in 2009 and has since logged more than 4,600 freefall parachute jumps.
