DEFERRED DISPOSITION APPLICATION AND CONDITIONS

On this date, the above named Defendant appeared in person, by attorney, or by mail, waived the right to a jury trial, entered a plea of **NO CONTEST**, and requests deferred disposition for the offense of _____ . Under the authority of Article 45.051, CCP, the Defendant requests a deferral of further proceedings in this case without entering an adjudication of guilt conditioned upon compliance with the following:

DEFERRAL PERIOD: 90 days. The deferral period will begin when the Judge approves the application for deferral.

CONDITIONS OF DEFERRED DISPOSITION

- 1. The full amount of the fine and court costs must be paid immediately and that such fees and/or court costs will not be returned.
- 2. **THE SIGNED AND COMPLETED DEFERRED DISPOSITION APPLICATION, A COPY OF YOUR VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE & PROOF OF INSURANCE (VALID AT THE TIME THE CITATION WAS ISSUED) MUST BE RETURNED TO THE MUNICIPAL COURT WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS FROM THE DATE YOU PAID AND SUBMITTED YOUR ONLINE REQUEST.**

You may mail these items to: Lubbock Municipal Court, P.O. Box 2000, Lubbock, Texas 79457, or bring them in person to the cashier window at the Municipal Court located at 1214 14th Street, Lubbock, Texas. Cashier window hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

NOTE: The Court assumes no responsibility for delayed, lost, misdirected, incomplete, or postage-due mail.

DURING THE DEFERRAL PERIOD, THE DEFENDANT SHALL:

- 3. NOT receive another violation during the deferral period, for any offense against the laws of the State of Texas or City of Lubbock, regardless of final conviction date.
- 4. The defendant shall notify the court within five (5) days of any change in address during the deferral period in person or by first-class mail, addressed to the Lubbock Municipal Court, P.O. Box 2000, Lubbock, Texas 79457.

VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE ABOVE FOUR REQUIREMENTS SHALL CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THE DEFERRED DISPOSITION AND MAY RESULT IN A CONVICTION.

If Defendant successfully complies with the conditions of this application, then the case shall be **DISMISSED** and shall **NOT** be reported as a conviction. Failure to comply with **all** requirements, including payment in full and non-receipt of required documents and/or incomplete forms shall violate the deferred disposition and may result in a **conviction** for this offense. Defendant acknowledges that if a conviction is entered, it will be reported as required by law.
