At Uga Escapes we are committed to inform guests, suppliers, and other interested parties about our animal welfare policies. Our vision is that all animals are treated with respect and in accordance with transparent and clear welfare standards. The protection of animals living in captivity and in the wild is very important to us.

The primary objectives of this policy are:

- The need to not interfere and don't change the animals natural behaviour.
- The need to maintain standards for animals who's live is impacted by tourism and our hotel operation.
- The need to accept their presence as our properties are in natural environments.
- The need to protect them from pain, suffering, cruelty and disease.

Through our animal welfare we are committed

- to only purchase fish, meat and dairy products from reliable and checked suppliers.
- to not offer any activities which might harm or change the natural behaviour of wild animals or even damage their environment.
- to not offer any activates in which guest directly interact with wild animals by touching, feeding or petting them.
- to maintain a standardized waste management to not attract wild animals and strays and to not support unnatural behaviour by eating human food waste.
- to make sure that domesticated animals (our horses) are well taken care of, well feed and that activities are limited and sufficient off times are granted.

To interact and live together with domesticated and wild animals should be considered as privilege and it's our responsibility as humans to make sure that their welfare is maintained and respected.
