Activity #1: Search the Catalogue

Begin this activity by clicking on the image of a library checkout card

- **1)** The Wizard wants you to search for their special book on wizard craft... How would you search for the book?
 - Use the library catalogue
- 2) What would you type into the Search field to search for this book? Did you try typing it in to see what you get?
 - Wizard spell book
- 3) What Filters would you use to narrow down your list?
 - Published Date we need books from the last 3 years
 - Do we want music or DVDs? No we just need books!



Activity #2: Booklists

Begin this activity by clicking on the image of a typewriter

- "You will stay here until you find me a list of 100 books! Fantasies are my favourite, but I love all Middle Grade books." Where will you look?
 - Check the Vancouver Public Library's booklists
- 2) Start at <u>www.vpl.ca</u> and click on the button that says "KIDS" Do you remember where to find all the booklist?
 [From <u>https://www.vpl.ca/kids</u>, scroll down to the booklist subsection, and click "see all booklists"] Use the "sort by" button at the top and choose "List name," then click the "Apply" button.

Do any of the books have "100" in the title? It looks like the list of 100 books has been split up into smaller lists. The wizard mentioned liking one sort of book the best. Can you see a list like that? [100 Middle Grade Books to Love: New Worlds (Fantasy Fiction)]

How many books are on the list you think the wizard will like best? Let's write that number down.
